PRIVACY POLICY

In accordance with the provisions of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (hereinafter referred to as “the Regulation”) in Article 13—Information to be provided when personal data is collected from the data subject,

MOBIL PLASTIC S.p.A.,

(hereinafter referred to as “the Company”), provides the following information regarding the processing of personal data of its customers (hereinafter referred to as “the Data”) carried out by the Company, in its capacity as Data Controller.

Identity of the Data Controller and contact details. In accordance with Article 4 of the Regulation, the Company is the Data Controller for the Data relating to its customers.

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Categories and types of data collected and processed

The data processed by the Company includes personal data that does not fall into special categories (Art. 9 of the Regulation), collected for the purpose of entering into the contract and in connection with the performance and/or conclusion of the contract.

It is also possible that personal data of third parties provided by customers may be processed. In this case, customers act as independent data controllers and assume the resulting legal obligations and responsibilities, releasing the Company from any liability in the event of a dispute, claim, and/or request for compensation for damages related to the processing that may be addressed to the Company by the third parties concerned. More specifically, the following information is collected:

- Information provided when you use our Services, including your contact information, details about your activities and performance, and information about the steps taken to recommend the product best suited to your needs.

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More specifically, the following information is collected:

- Information provided in connection with our business activities, including contact information, details regarding our activities and services, and banking information.

Purpose and legal basis of the processing, as well as the nature of the data disclosure

In accordance with applicable regulations on the protection of personal data and without the need for specific consent from the data subject, the data will be recorded, collected, and processed by the company for the following purposes:

- a) compliance with contractual obligations, performance and/or conclusion of the contract, and/or management of any pre-contractual measures;
- b) compliance with any regulatory obligations, tax and fiscal provisions arising from the conduct of business activities, and obligations related to administrative and accounting activities.

The legal bases for processing for the purposes a) and b) indicated above are Articles 6.1.b) and 6.1.c) of the Regulation.

The provision of data for the aforementioned purposes is optional; however, failure to provide such data and refusal to disclose it would make it impossible for the Company to perform and/or conclude the contract.

Data Processing Methods

For the purposes indicated, data processing is carried out using manual, computerized, and telematic tools, in accordance with procedures strictly related to those purposes and, in all cases, in a manner that ensures data security and confidentiality, as well as compliance with the specific obligations set forth in the regulations. The data will be processed in accordance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, relevance, and proportionality, in compliance with the provisions of the regulations on the protection of personal data. The processing will be carried out by duly designated and trained personnel.

Scope of data disclosure and dissemination, recipients and data transfers, as well as data processors

To this end, data may be disclosed to third parties designated as data processors, in accordance with Article 28 of the Regulation, when necessary for tax, administrative, or contractual reasons, or pursuant to requirements set forth in applicable regulations.

Finally, the data may be shared with authorities, organizations, and/or individuals to whom the data must be disclosed pursuant to legal provisions or orders from authorities. These authorities, organizations, and/or individuals will act as independent data controllers.

The data will not be disclosed.

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A complete and regularly updated list of the data controllers can be requested by sending an email to the Data Controller at the addresses listed above.

Transfer of data to international organizations and/or countries outside the EEA (European Economic Area)

Any transfer of data to international organizations and/or countries outside the EEA will be carried out in accordance with one of the methods authorized by applicable regulations, such as the consent of the data subject, the adoption of standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission, or the selection of entities participating in international programs for the free flow of data (for example, the EU-U.S. Privacy Shield) or operating in countries deemed safe by the European Commission.

Data Retention

The information will be retained for as long as you remain an active supplier to the company. The data will be stored in paper and/or electronic format only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected, in accordance with the principles of storage limitation and data minimization referred to in Article 5(1)(c) and (e) of the Regulation.

The data will be retained to comply with regulatory obligations and to pursue the aforementioned purposes, in accordance with the principles of necessity, proportionality, and relevance.

Information regarding terminated accounts will be retained to comply with the law, prevent fraud, resolve disputes, address issues, enforce our agreements, and take other actions permitted by law; Subsequently, once the aforementioned grounds justifying the processing have ceased to exist, the data will be erased, destroyed, or simply retained in an anonymous form.

Rights of the Data Subject

With regard to the aforementioned processing activities, each data subject may exercise the rights set forth in Articles 15 through 22 of the Regulation. In particular, the data subject has the right to request from the Company access to their data, its rectification, or its erasure; they have the right to object to the processing or to request the restriction of processing in the cases provided for in Article 18 of the Regulation, and to receive their data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format, in the cases provided for in Article 20 of the Regulation. The data subject may also revoke at any time

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consent given in accordance with Article 7 of the Regulation, as well as to file a complaint with the Data Protection Authority in accordance with Article 77 of the Regulation, if the data subject believes that the processing of their data violates applicable regulations. Requests must be submitted in writing to the Company at the addresses listed above.

Disclosure and Sharing

Your data may be disclosed (i.e., shared with one or more specific individuals) under the following conditions:

- to public or private entities that may access the data pursuant to legal, regulatory, or EU provisions, within the limits set forth by such rules (for example, social security and social welfare institutions and agencies, local government associations, public administrations and agencies, associations, foundations, non-profit organizations, and/or insurers)
- to individuals who need access to the data for purposes ancillary to the relationship between the parties, to the extent strictly necessary for the performance of such ancillary tasks (e.g., banks and financial institutions, service providers, carriers, and transportation companies)
- to our advisors, to the extent necessary for the performance of their duties within our organization, upon presentation of a letter of engagement from us imposing an obligation of confidentiality and security.

Under no circumstances will we disclose the data to unspecified third parties, nor will we make it available or allow it to be accessed, unless you have given your specific, free, and informed consent, expressed and granted for each type of processing.
